[306] THE EIGHTH APPEARANCE. JOHN 21:1-17 First. Jesus appears to seven of his disciples, who were fishing; they had not caught anything during the whole night, but when they cast out the net at his command, 'they could not pull it in because of the huge catch of fish'.
