vv. 14 'But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because **you know those from whom you learned it...**'

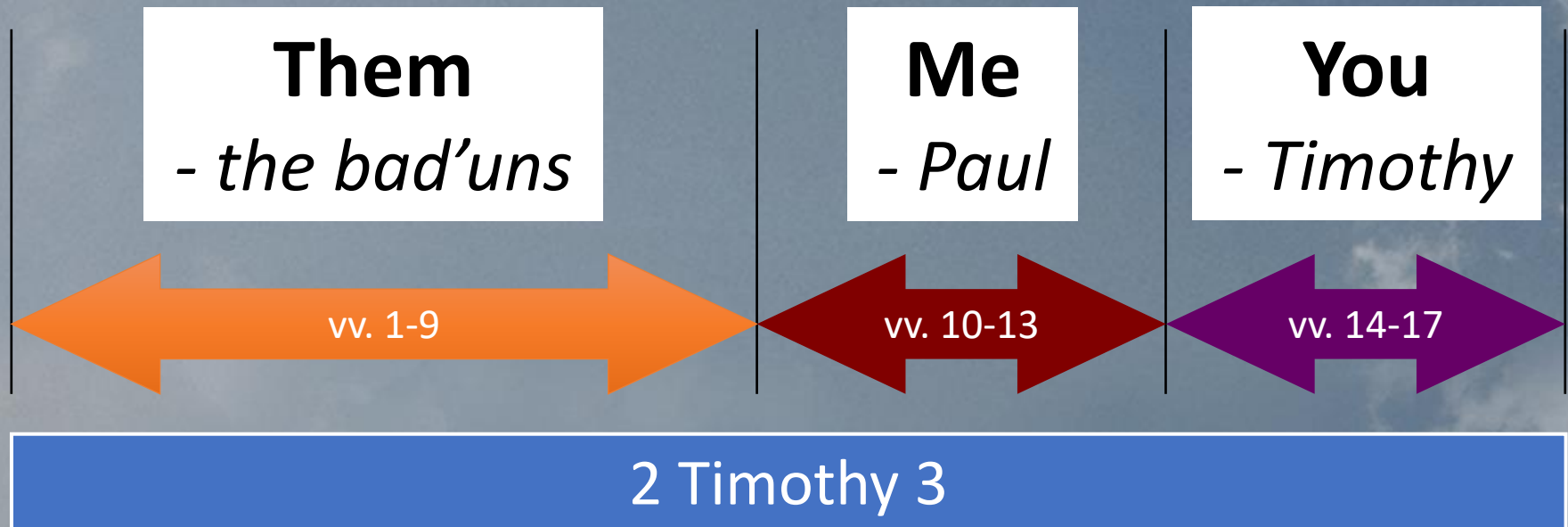
